DOCTORAL CONTRACTS IdA

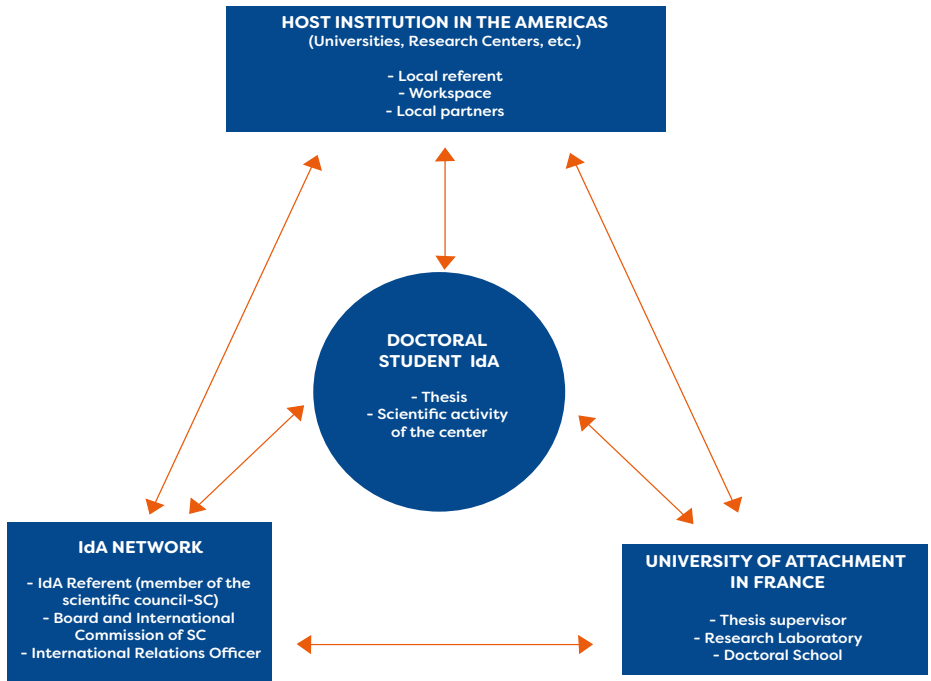
The international center is led by a coordinator who benefits from a doctoral contract with a duration of three years, under a partnership between IdA and the **French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation (MESRI)**.

In order to support international cooperation actions in the academic and scientific fields, four doctoral contracts are awarded each year by the M.E.S.R.I. The Institute of the Americas launches a **call for applications** every year for doctoral contracts of three years.

In addition to offering the doctoral student the means to conduct quality research with

a three-year allowance, the doctoral contract of IdA places primary importance on local integration in one of the twelve countries and partner institutions. The young researcher can easily conduct field research, acquire in-depth experience of the region he is studying and build a network of local relations that will be useful for the rest of his career. Such position requires the liking and ability to organize scientific events bringing together local partners and European or international researchers. This practical knowledge of organizing meetings or events and research administration are valuable skills for the professional future of the doctoral student.

WHAT IS AN IDA INTERNATIONAL CENTER?

The international center is located on the American continent. It aims to develop its activities on a regional scale in collaboration with local partners and in coordination with the French scientific, diplomatic, cultural and cooperation network.

THE 12 INTERNATIONAL CENTERS OF IDA AIM TO:

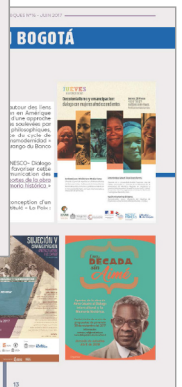
- Disseminate the research on the Americas to and from France, with an emphasis on transdisciplinary and trans-American dimensions
- Encourage exchange between European and American specialists, enabling the enrichment of scientific knowledge on the Americas
- Be a gateway to France and Europe, and participate in the construction of a Euro-American area of higher education and research.

Each international center is governed by a framework agreement signed between GIS IDA and one or several local partners who ensure its reception.
